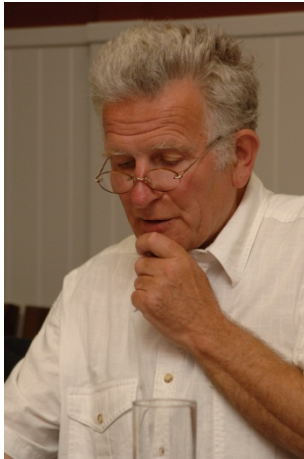


## COLIN BENNETT
